

MoPI BRIEFING PAPER

INTRODUCTION

The SunGard MoPI Manager Solution is designed to allow a force to meet its obligations under the MoPI Code of Practice and Guidance with regard to Retention, Review and Disposal of data concerning individuals.

The management of police data is a high volume activity, and the SunGard MoPI Manager Solution is designed to provide work management, prioritisation, and automation.

Effective management of police data requires a view of a person across multiple systems. The SunGard MoPI Manager Solution integrates with Person Indexing applications to achieve this.

Integration is a key aspect of the SunGard MoPI Manager Solution and it can support a variety of integration options with Person Indexing applications and Source Systems. Also it is designed to support incremental integration of further Source systems and Services for optional functionality.

Sungard is working in partnership with Microsoft to integrate the MoPI Manager Application with Microsoft Office Sharepoint and to extend the current MoPI Application features to include multimedia management and search.

SOLUTION DETAILS

The SunGard MoPI Manager Solution enables the management of records in key Police Systems, with regard to Record Retention, Review and Disposal.

An update is sent to MoPI Manager whenever a significant change occurs to records on any of the participating systems. This comprises sufficient information to identify records in the source systems, link together the separate business records, and show a summary of the information held. In addition it will enable the MoPI Manager to suggest retention status and review dates. The user will make record management decisions based on the MOPI Manager view

of the records, in conjunction with more detailed record information from source systems as required.

The SunGard MoPI Manager Solution uses 'Golden Person Records', which represent a specific individual within a Police Force's systems. This record comprises of one or more individual 'Linked Business Records' (e.g. Crime, Custody, Intelligence records etc), and acts as a single point of entry to manage the Person data across all these systems. The MOPI Manager integrates with Person Index applications, which build the 'Golden Person Record'. SunGard's recommended Person Indexing application for this is SunGard Public Sector LNI.

The SunGard MoPI Manager Solution is designed to handle high volumes of data by having the capability to automate the review process for specified sets of data, according to Force policy. Additionally record prioritisation is included.

The SunGard MoPI Manager Solution has work management, including allocation, monitoring and authorisation functionality.

The SunGard MoPI Manager Solution allows a variety of integration options with the Person Index application (for example LNI) and the Source Systems (different options may be appropriate for the different systems). Also it is designed to support incremental integration of further Source. The SunGard MoPI Manager Solution fits with integration platforms such as an ESB.

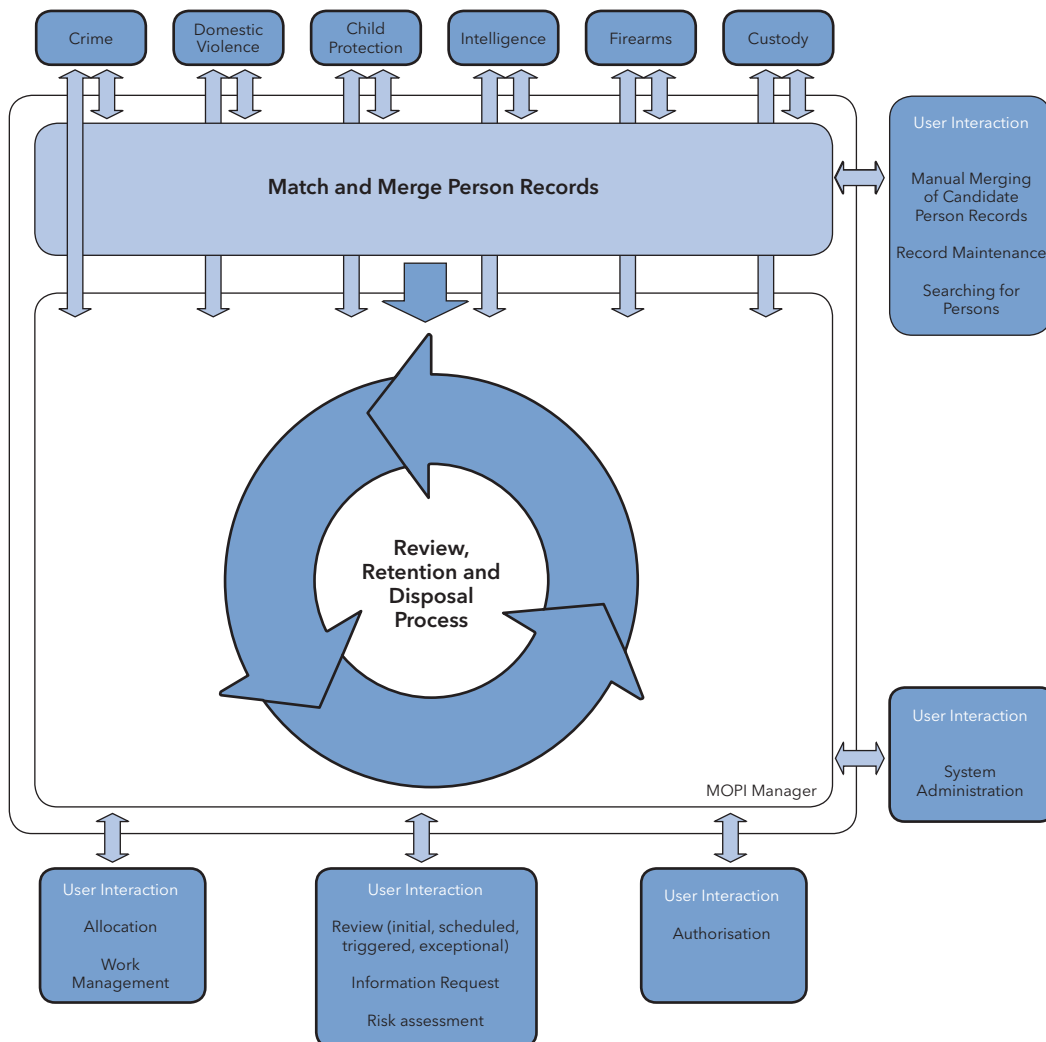


Figure 1 - System Context

The following diagram (Figure 1) illustrates the context of the MoPI Manager in relation to other systems, and application users.

MOPI Manager Phase 1 - System Context

- External systems

MOPI Manager - Screen Flow

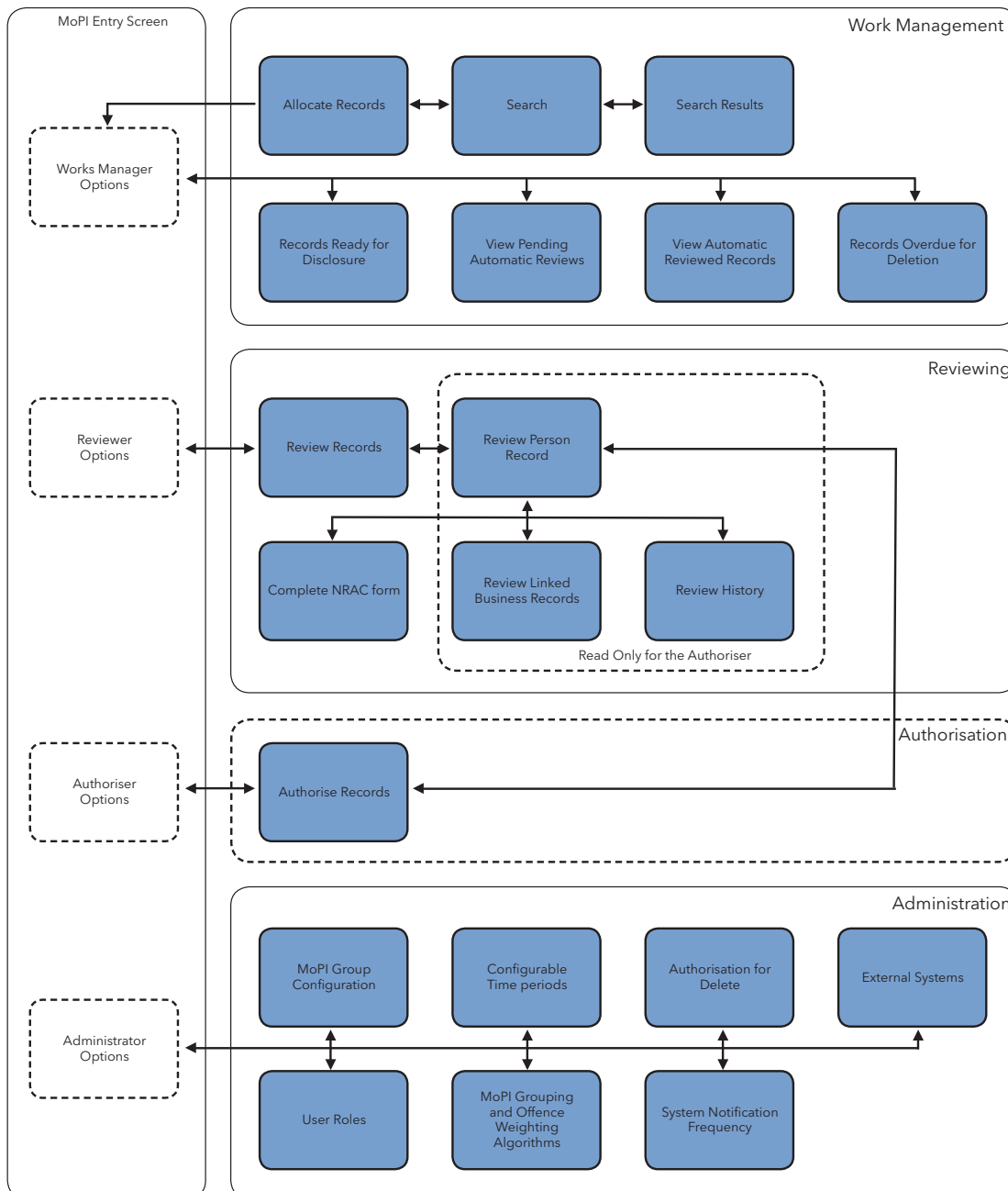
